1. Fresh Start Careers

3 days + 1 day (9.30–2.30) 1 week

Learners explore their career interests, personality preferences, values and skills. Learners compare this to the requirements of various occupations and courses and develop a career pathway and resume. One on one counselling will be available for each participant.

2. My Employability Skills

6 days: 9.30–2.30 plus work experience. 3 weeks

This program focuses on supporting learners gain relevant work experience in an industry of their choice. YouthNow has an extensive database of local employers across Melbourne's west which can support learners to gain the knowledge and experience they need to meet their career goals. The program includes a week of work experience.

Learners may choose to do this program together with Fresh Start Careers.
